Information for Foreign Applicants

According to recent changes in immigration law as of March 2006, foreign residents with student visas issued by the Japanese government have become eligible to enroll in the graduate programs offered by the University of Tsukuba at its campuses in Tokyo. (Classes for these programs are given in the evenings and on Saturdays, permitting students to pursue regular employment while earning classroom credits towards their degrees.)

In response to this situation, new qualifications based on Japanese language competency will be prerequisites for admission to most of these programs.

Foreign applicants who do not have permanent resident status require to demonstrate proficiency in Japanese by taking one of the Japanese language examinations listed below.

(Please note that this requirement does not extend to applicants to the Graduate School of Business Sciences, MBA Program in International Business who are required to demonstrate proficiency in English rather than Japanese)

Applicants must submit Certification (original only, return later) of test results to the Admissions Office with the application documents of the relevant program.
